## Da Vinci Hall Modernization

The 65, 920 square-foot Da Vinci Hall building is home to the Art and Architecture, Art gallery, Journalism, Photography and Ceramics programs. This project is the modernization of the 1962 three-story and one-story below ground concrete frame building.

Once completed, the renovated building will include new technological features that will help contribute to the student's educational success. This building will feature 24 classrooms, an AV classroom with technology upgrades, IT and security upgrades, and ADA Accessibility improvements. Some additional improvements that will be made to the building will include the installation of a new roof, seismic retrofit, updates to the building's fire protection, plumbing, electrical, and mechanical systems.
