Valley Academic & Cultural Center

The new 118,000 square foot Academic and Cultural Center will provide Los Angeles Valley College with a state-of-the-art media and performing arts facility. The three-story facility will include indoor and outdoor performing spaces such as a 430-seat Main Theatre, 221-seat Screening Theatre, and a 143-seat Horseshoe Theatre.

This building will also contain seven rehearsal, studio rooms, three theatres, large lecture halls, nine smart classrooms, and six audio/video labs. Lastly, the building will contain a college radio station, production/control rooms, and a scene shop for set building. This new facility will help meet the educational mission of Valley College.

Los Angeles Valley College offers an array of career, technical, transfer and workforce education programs. Among its 160 associate degree programs, Valley offers a well-respected Theater Arts program that mixes its production schedule and classes to serve both traditional and non-traditional students. This program integrates the college's professional standards and scholastic goals. Today, Valley is one of the leading community colleges in the state and its beautiful 105-acre campus is recognized as the first California community college to be recognized as a Tree Campus USA.
