Technology Learning Center

The new Technology Learning Center 2 building will include multiple specialized and general computer labs for computer software and hardware disciplines for the Computer Science department. This four-story, 41,000 gross square-foot building is sited on the southern part of campus.

The Technology Learning Center will also include office space for the campus safety department, faculty, staff and academic senate departments, the Westside Extension department, and the Business and Paralegal department. The building will provide critical support spaces for campus servers, technology equipment rooms, and house the campus back-up server facility, and building distribution frame.

The building incorporates unique design features such as energy efficient mechanical and lighting systems, energy management control and lighting controls, drought-tolerant native planting and water-efficient irrigation. The single-room width building allows for natural light and cross ventilation. The landscaping was designed to incorporate efficient storm water capture and reuse methods.
